GL will attempt to fix in Mobay on Saturday AM but also sent a picture to Mike to bring down replacement rheostat for January 2015 project. The specs on the rheostat are:
Heine EN 15-C, 7.1V max, 1.7Amp, 6V / 10 Watts

Likely good idea to bring 3rd BIO kit down in January as this is the weakest link in our equipment. One BIO kit with RetinoMax 2 sent home for repair Nov 15. What we need to bring for sure is pachmate & iCare tonometer for each team.

Finally the Random Dot E's were given out and we need to order at least 12 more. Again the simplest way to improve the project is with better screening of the children and Random Dot E remains the most effective. One thing we can look into is getting a Random Dot E as in iPad or android app in the future.
